Directions:

From Hwy 270 and Hwy 70, take 70 east to Hwy 94 exit 228 toward Weldon springs. Continue on Hwy 94 west to Augusta. Take Hwy 94 to Jackson Street (the second entrance to Augusta). Turn left on Jackson and go about 1/2 mile to High Street. Turn right on High. High becomes Augusta Bottom Road. Continue 3-1/2 miles to 6560 Augusta Bottom Road on right. If you get lost call the Bauermeister Studio at 636-228-4663. Please carpool if possible, parking is limited.
